We are very pleased to invite you to join the 7th annual Norfolk Open Churches Run which will follow the successful format of previous events.

It's the event which starts off the 2014 Norfolk Open Churches Week and 9 selected churches will be open with help on hand to enable you to learn more and to best enjoy the beauty of some of Norfolk's lovely churches. Refreshments will be offered at some of the churches as indicated in the Route Book. The Open Churches Week coincides with the centenary of the start of the Great War with commemorations around the county. Also the churches of the Barnham Broom Group are celebrating their 50th anniversary.

Richard and Maurice are again organising and handling the administration of the Car Run with the help of the Norwich Diocesan office. The Lord Bishop of Norwich, the Right Reverend Graham James will start the cars off from the Cathedral. We hope to have a short 'pit-stop' service at the church at the end of the Run.

Entry is £17.50 for car with driver +1 passenger. Extra passengers £5 each. The entry charge provides you with a full Route Book for the day with option of coffee or tea and pastry in The Refectory Coffee Bar before the start. You may care to take your own picnic, but on the route there are several pubs and cafes where refreshments can be taken. As last year, any profits from the Run will go to The Norfolk Churches Trust and will be used to help the building and renovation funds of local churches.

Please be sure and send in your entry form early, as we have limited parking at the Cathedral. In 2013 we had to refuse many late entrants.

We are looking forward to welcoming you to the 2014 Norfolk Open Churches Classic Car Run - we are sure will be a great day out.
