

If you are not satisfied that a safeguarding issue has been dealt with appropriately and you are unable to resolve the matter with the Safeguarding Advisers then please contact the Bishop of Thetford on 01953 528010 or email: bishop.thetford@dioceseofnorwich.org who will offer you the opportunity to talk about your concerns and then look into the matter further.

To fulfil their commitment to safeguard and promote the welfare of children and adults, all organisations that provide services for, or work with, children and adults are required to have appropriate whistle-blowing procedures, and a culture that enables issues about safeguarding and promoting the welfare of children and adults to be addressed.

The policy of the Diocese of Norwich is to safeguard the interests of any of its employees, Office holders or volunteers when they act as alerters regarding any neglect or abuse, mental, physical, emotional, sexual, racial/ethnic or financial, of service users or any similar abuse of colleagues.
