- Title text readable 6 metres away (point size 48)
- Standard text readable 2 metres away (point size 24)
- · Use bullet points if necessary

Fonts

- Use a limited number
- Is it legible from a distance?
- Ensure white space surrounds text
- Don't use block capitals


