Listen: What is our Church?

Read Acts 2:42-47. Notice what strikes you - a word, a phrase, or an image. Keep 5 minutes of silence. In 2s or 3s share one thing that struck you from that passage.

Celebrate: What are we like?

When are we like the church in Acts? What does our church community do well? Share examples from your experience.

Imagine: What could we be?

What do we need to do to be more like the church in Acts - one simple idea and one radical?

Empower: How do we become?

What resources do we need to make those steps? Who do we need to talk to inside our church, parish, diocese, and in the wider world?
