# REIMAGINING CHURCH REFLECTION 4

#### Listen: What is our Church?

Read Luke 6:36-38. Notice what strikes you – a word, a phrase or an image. Keep 5 minutes of silence. In twos or threes share one thing that struck you from that passage.

#### Celebrate: What are we like?

When do we most closely follow the way of Jesus? When we avoid falling into the trap of judgementalism! When do we show mercy, forgive, and give abundantly?

### Imagine: What could we be?

What could we do that would give something extravagantly worthwhile to our local community, or demonstrate mercy?

## Empower: How do we become?

There may be stumbling blocks either in ourselves or in our lack of resources. Both matter. How do we tackle them in the light of Jesus' call for us to match what we have been given?
