Upon the representation of the Diocesan Advisory Committee of the Diocese of Norwich and following consultation with the Archdeacons in the diocese of Norwich.

In exercise of the power conferred by Section 78(1) of the Measure the Chancellor makes the following Order:

An authorised person may undertake any matter prescribed in the first column of the table in the Schedule without a Faculty subject to any conditions that are specified in relation to that matter in the corresponding place in the second column of the table;

Words and expressions used in this Order have the same meaning as they have in Part 3 of the Faculty Jurisidiction Rules 2015.

Matter:	Specified Conditions:
Matter: The installation of Info Point (or similar site-specific deliverers of multimedia content to any mobile device) in church buildings within the jurisdiction of the Consistory Court for the diocese of Norwich.	 Any device installed must not be capable of connection to the internet. The installation a device (including extenders) can only take place with the written permission of the Archdeacon or (if refused) by faculty. The Archdeacon will decide whether the intended location for a proposed device is appropriate.
	 No device (or extender) may be fixed to the fabric of any church without faculty permission.
	 All content loaded to the device for delivery to any mobile device must be prepared by (or on behalf of) the PCC (or similarly authorised
	persons) of a particular church and

- be appropriate for those able to access it.
- 6. Content for delivery to mobile devices must not infringe ecclesiastical or secular law, including the law pertaining to copyright.
- 7. The Archdeacon must approve the type of content that the PCC (or similarly authorised persons) proposes to load to the device.
- 8. For the avoidance of doubt, "content" refers to any content, including photographs.

This Order shall take effect from the first day of the month following the date of this Order.
