Upon the representation of the Diocesan Advisory Committee of the Diocese of Norwich and following consultation with the Archdeacons in the diocese of Norwich.

In exercise of the power conferred by Section 78(1) of the Measure the Chancellor makes the following Order:

An authorised person may undertake any matter prescribed in the first column of the table in the Schedule without a Faculty subject to any conditions that are specified in relation to that matter in the corresponding place in the second column of the table;

Words and expressions used in this Order have the same meaning as they have in Part 3 of the Faculty Jurisdiction Rules 2015.

Matter:	Specified Conditions:
The installation of standard form Commonwealth War Grave signs in churchyards within the Diocese, by The Commonwealth War Graves Commission.	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Signs shall not be installed until:<ol style="list-style-type: none">a) The installation has been the subject of an affirmative resolution from the relevant PCC; andb) The location and fixings of the sign have been approved by the relevant Archdeacon.2. The signs installed shall be of the style in the sample attached to this Order and in dimension either 230mm x 420mm or 150mm x 210mm.

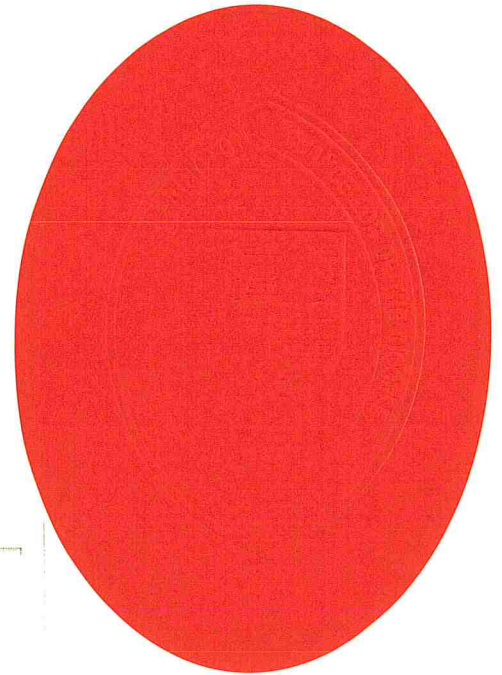
This Order shall take effect from the first day of the month following the date of this Order.
