

Trusting God to equip us with all we need

ur Church youth group started as a safe place for young people to meet, make friends and be introduced gently to faith. From the start, young people without any church connections came and the group gradually formed its own very particular identity. It fed the hungry, accepted those with special needs, supported those with experience of care, and ended each week by praying a blessing over all.

In May, it seemed that the vision was at an end. The diverse needs of the group seemed more than we could cater for. Behaviour turned from challenging to unpleasant, with potential to escalate. The youth worker and volunteers had needs in their

own lives that had to take priority. In an interregnum there was no vicar to turn to for support.

The youth worker spoke to the group and announced that this would be the last gathering...for a while...and went away joining others (including weekly prayer with a lay reader) in praying for the group and the future.

Over the summer, the youth worker invited families to their home and visited some of them in their homes, a skating trip and pizza making session was organised and relationships grew and deepened.

More of the young people came on a Sunday to church. God continued working in their lives and their families. At our area meet-up with other youth groups,

change was becoming evident. Phones were away, worship songs were sung, talks were listened to – in a way that had not happened before. Eight young people wanted to come to the Diocese youth weekend away – and all weekend the 'children' came to Jesus without being hindered (Matthew 19:14). A new, experienced volunteer emerged who already knew most of the young people.

One young person said: 'I always feel part of the group and I can mix with other young people, not necessarily in foster care. I like to be part of this'.

And so, to test out running the group again in the church building just before Christmas – the usual fun and games and talking together about where God's light is needed in a dark world.

This is the prophetic heart of what we are doing to see both individuals and the group transformed. Showing God's love, listening to these young people, accepting where they are at, talking to their parents, both natural and foster ones, about what is needed to help each one feel included, and above all, praying that God will continue to bless us as a group.

Our confidence is not in our ability to meet the diverse needs of these very individual young people, but we continue to trust God to equip us with all we need to continue shining His light.

Using your voice for meaningful change

It is imperative for the future that we teach young people now they can use their voice for meaningful change.

I always prioritise pupil voice in schools where I work but I am (fairly) new to working in Church of England Voluntary Aided schools and the SIAMs framework. When I started exploring it I was encouraged to read about the importance of pupil voice and courageous advocacy.

To enable this, we looked at the structure and use of Pupil Parliament (school council). We decided that a regular, timetabled meeting with the Headteacher and other relevant staff members was key to ensuring change was imminent and not lost in communication.

We also felt it would be more developmental to change the representative every week so that the whole class understood that



they could use their voice within this system.

The children feel very strongly about environmental issues and are looking at trying to reduce landfill waste in our schools, especially single use plastic in lunchboxes. This is an important issue for their generation and one I am very keen to support.

We need to spend time with our young people working out what they want to change rather than tokenistic groups.
