

Black History Month British Icons Resource



This curated resource has been created by The Diocese of Norwich to support all schools to 'Flourish Together' during Black History Month. The Diocese of Norwich recognise that Black History Month is a starting point, and these resources are intended as a supplement, not a replacement, for other continued work on meaningful representation in the curriculum.

This resource was created with the vision of ensuring that all children develop a deep understanding of our collective Black-British History that recognises and values the varied and rich contributions of the black community to British communities, our wider society, and our individual lives. This resource aims to support schools to improve

representation and ensure that our diverse school communities have a range of British and local role models to respect and inspire. This resource will support children to become as familiar with British icons as they are with world-renowned icons and may be used as a starting point during Black History Month.

























This resource is adaptable for all key stages therefore teachers and schools must use their pupil knowledge when deciding whether the icons and websites listed are age appropriate. Whilst this resource predominantly celebrates black British icons, schools may choose to celebrate other icons from other ethnic groups.




Teaching Ideas and Activities

It is suggested that a year group takes a theme e.g. music and then each class chooses one icon to study in depth. Example suggested activities:

- Children work independently, or in teams, to create a presentation on an icon
- Write a biography or information page to add to a whole class/school Black-British History Month book
- Using clips from online resources, write and create their own interview with a chosen icon
- Create a whole school Black-British art gallery with a museum label underneath to showcase achievements and contributions of black icons, whilst highlighting cultural backgrounds
- Create a quiz about a Black-British icon
- Create their own work of art mirroring their chosen icon (eg. Benjamin Zephaniah - create a dub poem)
- Children design and create their own commemorative plaques e.g. *similar to English Heritage* that could be added to a map of Great Britain
- Design information posters and artwork to contribute to a whole school gallery
- Take opportunities to explore the cultural heritage of the icon studied
